Here in Argentina, during the 70s, Mercedes Benz sells a series of 220D, I don't know if the proper word in english is "wagons". There was a single cabin pickup, a double cabin pickup (the most popular) and an estate. The base was obviously German, I don't know what work they did here, but I suppose not much.

Since imported cars were banned here at that time, this "wagons" were the only legal chance to get a Merc for the people who could afford it (very few). In other words, those Mercs where a status symbol in those years.
